Enjoy the Atlantic Canada Trap Championships

General Information:

This shoot is sanctioned by the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) and the Atlantic Provinces Trapshooting Association (APTA). Official ATA rules will govern shooting in all events and all shooters must be members of the ATA. ATA memberships may be purchased at the registration desk.

Shoot management reserves the right to reject any entry or change the program as conditions warrant.

Shoot management insists on safe gun handling at all times. Shooters that enter the competition agree to abide by the ATA and Highland Gun Club safety rules. Violators subject themselves to disqualification, without recourse, and may be required to leave the grounds.

Shooters are reminded that ATA and Club rules prohibit consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs during participation in any event or sub-event, between events or sub-events, and including shoot-offs.

Eye and Ear protection is mandatory for all shooters and referees. The club canteen will be open during the shoot.

Classification - Minimum Target Requirements

All shooters are requested to check with the Classification Committee before shooting and have their ATA Average Card up to date. Classification will be determined by average and known ability.

The minimum target requirement per event is 300 ATA Registered targets in the previous 2 target years - 2017 & 2018. Please note that Preliminary Day targets may be used to meet the target requirements for Championship Events 4, 5 & 6. Shooters not meeting these target requirements shall be assigned a minimum penalty classification of:

SINGLES / DOUBLES: Class B or higher. HANDICAP: 2 Yard penalty.

Special Category Declaration:

All category shooters must declare their special category at the time of their classification.

Trophies:

Only shooters that <u>reside</u> in the Atlantic Provinces are eligible for the CLOSED trophies. <u>All</u> shooters (regardless of residency) will be eligible for the ADDED MONEY & OPEN trophies.

All other optional monetary purses are open to all shooters regardless of residency. In a HIGH GUN PURSE only the top scores pay out.

The LEWIS OPTIONS are percentage based and ties will divide the purse. The CLASS PURSES will have each class shooting for its own money.





Shoot-offs:

Shoot-offs/ties for Events 1 & 3 will be resolved by carry-over in Championship Events 4 & 5 respectively. Shoot-offs/ties for Event 2 will be conducted prior to the start of Event 5. All ties for the Championship Events - Events 4, 5, and 6 will be shot off each day if possible.

All shoot-offs will be shot off in 25 target events for Singles and Handicap and 10 pairs for Doubles. Shooters not reporting for shoot-offs in a timely manner will forfeit all rights to any trophies involved. Shoot-offs will be called within 20 minutes of the completion of the regular day's program events.

Shooter's Responsibility:

Each shooter is responsible for checking their score as posted and to make sure their money options are indicated properly. No score will be changed once the Purse or Option monies have been posted.

Due to the number of shooters expected, shooters are requested to be at the shooting line and prepared to move to the Trap immediately after the previous squad finishes shooting. Any shooter missing their squad will be re-squadded at the end of the event.

Target Setting / Targets:

The Target Setting Committee will set targets each morning and for event changes. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules and shall be only reset if they vary from ATA standards. The final decision as to whether or not a trap is to be reset shall be made by a member of the Target Setting Committee.

Lawry All-Orange targets will be used for all events.

Presquadding

Shooters are asked and encouraged to presquad for the shoot. All shooters that presquad by August 19, 2018 will be eligible to win a case of target ammunition for the AP Championship Event 4 or Events 5 & 6. Presquadding services will be provided on: www.presquad.com. Please help shoot management by presquadding.

Business Meeting:

The APTA annual general meeting will be held directly after Event 5 on Sunday, September 2, 2018. All APTA shooters are urged to attend.

Ammunition

Factory shells will be available on site and shooters are asked to confirm their order by August 3rd (see note in booklet).
