

GENERAL INFORMATION

This shoot is sanctioned by the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) and the Atlantic Provinces Trapshooting Association (APTA). ATA rules will govern shooting in all events.

Shoot Management insists on safe gun handling at all times. Shooters who enter the competition agree to abide by the ATA and St. John's Rod and Gun Club safety rules. Violators subject themselves to disqualification, without recourse, and may be required to leave the grounds.

Shoot Management reserves the right to reject any entry or change the program as conditions warrant. Shoot Management also reserves the right to disqualify, or refuse entry to anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of the shoot in any manner.

Payment will be by cash or cheque made payable to the St. John's Rod and Gun Club. There will be no refunds on targets, trophies or options unless an event is cancelled.

Please show courtesy to other shooters by refraining from loud or boisterous conduct while behind shooters still competing on the firing line, especially during the handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated.

REGISTRATION

The registration desk will open at 10 AM on Thursday, August 29 and at 8 AM on all other event days. Shoot Management asks that shooters familiarize themselves with all shoot entry fees and purses. This will avoid unnecessary registration delays.

Presquadding will be available through www.presquad.com starting July 1, 2019. Shoot Management asks that all shooters avail of this service as it reduces event registration completion times.

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

Classification Committee

Classification will be determined by current target year average and known ability. Known ability will consider official shooting averages, non registered scores and any other information determining a shooter's ability. All shooters are requested to have their ATA Average Card up to date before presenting to

the Classification Committee for classification. Up to date Average Cards printed from the ATA's Shooter Information Center will be accepted for classification.

Penalty Classification

Singles: Shooters with less than 300 total 16 yard targets registered for

the current and previous target year will be assigned to "B" class or

higher at the discretion of the Classification Committee.

Doubles: Shooters with less than 300 total Doubles targets registered

for the current and previous target year will be assigned to $\ensuremath{\text{``B''}}$

class or higher at the discretion of the of the Classification

Committee.

Handicap: Shooters with less than 300 total Handicap targets registered

for the current and previous target year will be assigned a minimum penalty yardage of 22 yards unless otherwise noted. Sub-

Jr., Jr. or Sr. Veteran age shooters will be assigned a minimum penalty yardage of 20 yards. Penalty yardage will be assigned at

the discretion of Classification Committee.



SPECIAL CATEGORY DECLARATION

It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashiering for the first event entered. Once Category declarations have been made by the shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.

Any Category Shooter tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry over for the Championship Trophy. If the Category shooter fails in the trophy shoot-off/carry over, they will fall back to the declared Category. A Category shooter whose score qualifies for a trophy in their declared Category, may not fall back to place or class. Where there is no Category Trophy offered, the Category shooter is eligible to shoot for Class / Place trophies without forfeiting their



TIES AND SHOOT OFFS

Ties in Preliminary Day Events will carry over to the next like sub-event. Handicap ties will be shot off before the next Handicap event and will be scheduled as time permits by the Shoot Committee. All Ties in the Championship events 4 - 8 will be resolved by shoot-off as per ATA rules.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

Each shooter is responsible for checking their score as posted and to make sure their money options are indicated properly. No score will be changed once the Purse or Option monies have been posted.

Due to the number of shooters expected, and in an effort to complete the events in a timely manner, shooters are requested to be at the shooting line promptly and prepared to shoot after the previous squad finishes shooting. Shoot Management also asks that squads move through events without any unnecessary delays or breaks. Your cooperation is appreciated.

TARGET SETTING / TARGETS

The Target Setting Committee will set targets each morning and for event changes. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules and shall be only reset only if they vary from ATA standards. The final decision whether or not a trap is to be reset shall be made by a member of the Target Setting Committee.

White Flyer orange dome targets will be used for all events. Pat Traps and voice activate release systems will be used on all fields.

AMMUNITION

The Gun Dealer is the official ammunition supplier for this shoot. Shooters requiring ammunition are asked to contact The Gun Dealer directly to place orders. 




