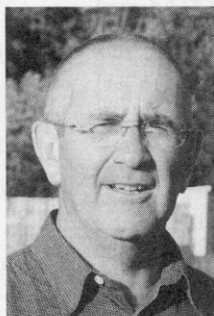

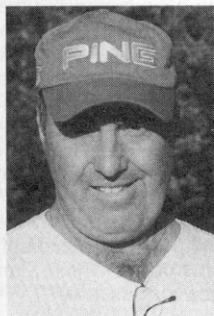
Jerry Stafford captures singles crown, Ed MacInnes paces feature handicap

Carl d'Entremont downed 90 doubles targets to snare the title outright at the Atlantic Provinces Provincial Shoot Aug. 30-Sept. 1 at Greenwood R&GC in Kingston, N.S.

Jerry Stafford topped the Singles Championship with 192, and Edward MacInnes secured the handicap crown with 93 from 20. According to TRAP & FIELD records, this was Stafford's fifth singles title. He also has one all-around and four doubles championships to his credit.

Senior vet Donald Stevens, 1996 handicap champ, headed all-around scoring with 364x400. He carded 190 in the feature 16s and bested James Hannah in one overtime round for runnerup honors. He bagged the second-place trophy in the main doubles with 89.

Leo Atkinson placed second in the main handicap with 91 from 22, and Ken Brunt registered 90 from 21.5 for third. Sherman Ogilvie's 89 from 19.5 earned him fourth-place recognition, and 22-yarder Clyde d'Entremont placed fifth with 88. Wayne Crowell rounded out the ATA trophy winners with 86 from 23 for sixth place.

Stafford topped Friday's singles with 98, then won the twins with 92. Andrea Bassan collected first-place handicap honors with 93 from 20.

Officers for 2003 were elected during the

shoot. Jim Hannah will again serve as ATA Delegate, and Jerry Stafford and Ken Brunt are first and second alternates, respectively. State officers are Andrea Bassan, president; Ed MacInnes, vice president; and Stafford, secretary-treasurer.
