GENERAL INFORMATION

This shoot is sanctioned by the Amateur Trapshooting Association (ATA) and the Atlantic Provinces Trapshooting Association (APTA). ATA rules will govern shooting in all events.

Shoot Management insists on safe gun handling at all times. Shooters who enter the competition agree to abide by the ATA and host club safety rules. Violators subject themselves to disqualification, without recourse, and may be required to leave the grounds.

Shoot Management reserves the right to reject any entry or change the program as conditions warrant. Shoot Management also reserves the right to disqualify, or refuse entry to anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of the shoot in any manner.

Please be courteous to other shooters by refraining from loud or boisterous conduct while behind shooters still competing on the firing line, especially during the handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated.

REGISTRATION

Shooters are asked to presquad for the tournament using www.presquad.com. Presquadding services will open July 1st, 2021.

CLASSIFICATION AND HANDICAPPING

Classification will be determined by current target year average and known ability. Known ability will consider official shooting averages, non registered scores and any other information determining a shooter's ability. All shooters are requested to have their ATA Average Card up to date before presenting to the Classification Committee for classification. Up to date Average Cards printed from the ATA's Shooter Information Center will be accepted for classification.

Penalty Classification

Shooters with less than 300 ATA registered targets, dating back to the start of the 2019 target year, will be assigned a classification based on their last established ATA average and yardage. New shooters without an established average will be classified based on known ability.

Shooters are asked to have all available target history available for presentation to the classification committee at time of registration.

All classification determinations are at the discretion of the classification committee.

SPECIAL CATEGORY DECLARATION

It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashiering for the first event entered. Once Category declarations have been made by the shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.

Any Category Shooter tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry over for the Championship Trophy. If the Category shooter fails in the trophy shoot-off/carry over, they will fall back to the declared Category. A Category shooter whose score qualifies for a trophy in their declared Category, may not fall back to place or class. Where there is no Category Trophy offered, the Category shooter is eligible to shoot for Class / Place trophies without forfeiting their special Category status should they lose. Any Category Shooter whose score does not qualify for a trophy in their category may compete for place, or class trophies.

TIES AND SHOOT OFFS

Ties in all Singles and Doubles Preliminary Day Events will be determined by a carry over to the next event. Ties in all Handicap events will be determined before the start of the next Handicap event at the discretion of the shoot committee and as time permits.

Ties in all Championship Events will be resolved by a shoot-off at the discretion of the shoot committee and as time permits.

SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

Each shooter is responsible for checking their score as posted and to make sure their money options are indicated properly. No score will be changed once the Purse or Option monies have been posted.

Due to the number of shooters expected, and in an effort to complete the events in a timely manner, shooters are requested to be at the shooting line promptly and prepared to shoot after the previous squad finishes shooting. Shoot Management

also asks that squads move through events without any unnecessary delays or breaks. Your cooperation is appreciated.

TARGET SETTING / TARGETS

The Target Setting Committee will set targets each morning and for event changes. Targets will be set in accordance with ATA rules and shall only be reset if they vary from ATA standards. The final decision on whether or not a trap is to be reset shall be made by a member of the Target Setting Committee.

AMMUNITION

Contact the host club should you require ammunition. All orders must be placed by July 31, 2021

TROPHIES

Only shooters that <u>reside</u> in the Atlantic Provinces are eligible for the Closed (Resident) trophies. <u>All</u> shooters (regardless of residency) are eligible for the Open trophies. Please note that all Closed (Resident) trophies are awarded above Open trophies for Resident shooters.
