In 2019 it was used to help fund Phase 1 of the Trap Improvment Project. The 2020 grant went to funding Phase 2.

Phase 1







Rebuild Traphouse 2B

The club's oldest traphouse (built in the early 70s) had become structurally unsafe. The concrete was crumbling and not repairable, so it was replaced with a larger and taller concrete traphouse meeting ATA specifications.



General Improvements

- Patched, repaired and painted the exterior concrete walls on the remaining traphouses.
- Completed general landscape improvements on the trapfields- removed rocks, added topsoil, levelled areas, and hydroseeded as needed.

Phase 2





Rebuild Traphouse 1B

Traphouse 1B was originally built from concrete blocks in 1975. It was partially rebuilt in 2006 but the walls and roof had become structurally unsafe again due to age and water penetration from a high water table and poor drainage. The drainage issue was corrected and the traphouse replaced with a concrete traphouse identical to Traphouse 2B

New Concrete Walkways on Trapfield 1B





Before- Narrow, cracked and uneven shooting walkways.

After- Wider, sidewalk style shooting walkways.



Phase 3 and 4 Items

- Complete landscaping repairs around the new walkways next spring.
- Continue replacing walkways on the other trapfields to prepare for the 2022 Atlantics



All work, except the heavy equipment and excavation work, was done by the club trapshooters.
